

Welcome!! In this class we will be focusing on learning the elements of art, principles of design, and expressing thoughts and/or feelings through different mediums. This class contains both academic measures such as worksheets and tests in addition to the composition and critiquing of new art works; in short, students will be assessed both on their learning of design and execution of art throughout the year, and this is non-negotiable.

Course Objectives:

- φ Students will be held to the Arizona state standards for visual arts
- φ Students will be learning established academic/genre specific vocabulary to discuss and critique art & design
- φ Students will be learning established academic/genre specific vocabulary to discuss and critique ceramics
- φ Students will be learning how to deal with a variety of different sculpting mediums, learning the characteristics and weaknesses of each in planning and executing designs
- φ Students will generate a variety of work intended to show self-expression and improvement of specific artistic and design skills and/or abilities
- φ Students will produce a volume of work in a variety of mediums and reflect upon different mediums and concepts in a gallery/show environment as well as a personal, professional portfolio

Students are required to provide the following materials for the class:

- φ A work apron of adequate length to protect clothing, to be kept in organized workspace
- φ \$30 class materials fee, paid at the beginning of the semester to the 4A

While I appreciate the artistic genius of Picasso and his philosophy that all art is “stolen” from others, plagiarism will NOT be tolerated. Inspiration from sources such as the Internet, magazines, and other such media is encouraged and welcome; replication will be viewed as plagiarism and will result in a 0 for the assignment/project, with no further opportunity provided to make up the failed work.
